From Rev. Ian. Vicar of Lingfield & Dormansland

It is difficult to believe, when there is so much discord and breakdown of relationship whether it be in a global setting or a personal

one, but we are wired for both connection and transformation, it is a profound testament to the beauty of our humanity. But how do we find that connection.

The answer lies in cultivating a quiet stillness of our inner life and that fuels meaningful action. Our lives are so full on, so full of things do, so noisy, that finding the time to stop and be still, to be quiet seems impossible. I had a conversation recently with a lady who was asking about if all churches were open for people to walk into and be quiet, to be still just for a short while because she found it so hard to find time to do that in her daily life (The Chapel at St Johns and the Church at St Peter and St Paul Lingfield are open every day for exactly this reason).

When we pause to meet the divine presence within (whatever we believe that means), we gain clarity, strength, and a renewed sense of purpose. This is not merely a retreat from the world but a preparation to engage with it fully. Whether through prayer, meditation, contemplation or simple moments of quiet, we earn the capacity to pour love, courage, and vitality into our actions. From these moments of connection, we find the resolve to speak truth, dismantle injustices, and support others with unwavering compassion.





Dormansland Parish Council



By the time you are reading this, we hope that we will have appointed a new Parish Clerk. Interviews will have taken place in mid January and we will be looking forward to introducing the successful candidate to you in the early Spring.

We were grateful to Clutterbucks for filling the salt bins in time for the snow and ice. Please remember the salt is for public areas only. It should not be used on private land and that only a small amount is required to be effective. There is a guidance note in each bin.

We are aware that the roof of the bus shelter opposite St John's Church needs some attention, and we have contracted a roofing company to replace the wooden shingles. We did consider putting on a felt roof but thought the cedar shingles would look more attractive and last longer. Both bus shelters in Dormansland have a wooden shingle roof.

Replacing the Union flag proved more difficult than we expected, but we are still on the case and plans are afoot to have a new one flying on the New Hache Green soon.

The long awaited Vehicle Activated Signs, VAS, should be fitted in the near future. A post has been sited near the lamp post by the build out nearest to St John's Church on the same side as the church. We are now awaiting a dry day when the technicians might attach an electrical connection and then the VAS sign will be fitted by the company who made them. The obsolete solar powered VAS sign on the opposite side of the road has been removed. A second VAS sign will be fitted on the post of the obsolete sign outside the War Memorial Community Hall on Plough Road.

We are seeking a new Parish Councillor to join the Council. There should be seven Councillors in a parish the size of Dormansland but at the moment we are only six. The role requires significant effort but is extremely interesting. It is unpaid. The Council's work is to continue to

make Dormansland an attractive place in which to live. If you wish to serve on the Parish Council please see details on the Parish website or contact the Parish Clerk at the email address below or you may leave a message on 07395 323456 and someone will get back to you.

Neighbourhood Watch Update

Latest available reported crime between 7th November 2024 and 15th January 2025. Please remember these statistics are only as good as the information received so please report any crimes to ensure both an accurate reflection but also greater support from Surrey Policing for our village.

Three crimes have been advised via the Tandridge Neighbourhood Watch Newsletter for Dormansland during this 10 week period.

Robbery. Station Road, Dormansland. Around 15.30 on 11th November a young male was assaulted in an alleyway close to Dormansland Station. His coat was taken from him and he was hit multiple times with a metal pole causing injuries. Detailed descriptions have been provided and information about the school that the group of males involved attend. Enquiries are progressing and one male has been arrested.

Criminal Damage. St Piers Lane, Dormansland. At 13.58 on 11th November two groups of youths were seen causing damage to a derelict building. On police attendance one young male was arrested but three escaped all aged between 12 and 14 years.

Vehicle Crime. New Farthingdale, Dormansland. At around 21.00 on 14th December three young males, one of whom was wearing bright orange clothing, smashed the windows and lights on a car before running off towards Hollow Lane.

Please join the Neighbourhood Watch community as additional information is shared, providing guidance on how to secure your property, scams etc, which are all very useful.






